ANZAC Day, celebrated on April 25 in both Australia and New Zealand, is the day when we remember the soldiers of the Australian and New Zealand Army Corps (ANZACS) who landed and fought on the Gallipoli Peninsula in Turkey early on the morning of April 25 1915 during the First World War (1914-1918). We remember their bravery and sacrifice, many of them never returning home from the war.

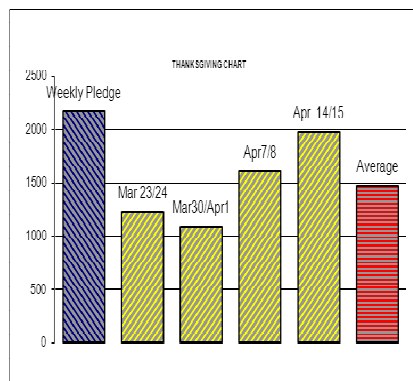

Feast Days of the Week

Wed Apr 25 ANZAC Day

Thu Apr 26 St Mark, Evangelist

Author of the first Gospel to be written. Believed to be the young man who ran away when Jesus was arrested (Mark 14:51-52), and the 'John whose other name was Mark' (Acts 12:25). The disciple of St Peter who travelled with him to Rome, and was referred to by Peter as "my son Mark". Travelled with his cousin St Barnabas, and with St Paul through Cyprus.

Wed Apr 28 St Peter Chanel - Priest & martyr 1803-1841

Coming from a peasant family in France, Peter Chanel was

ordained in 1827 and entered the Society of Mary (Marist Fathers) four years later. In 1836 he led a group of Marist Fathers to the New Hebrides where he converted many, often as a result of his work with the sick. He learned the local language, and taught in the local school, and became known as 'the man with the kind heart'. Killed by a native king who was jealous of Peter's influence, Peter became the first Christian martyr in Oceania.
