

We might see the Pope celebrating the Easter ceremonies on the news, and we may even see and hear reports of local celebrations. We attend the ceremonies ourselves, and are caught up in the greatest miracle ever. Jesus died, as we all do eventually, the victim of injustice and cruelty, but Jesus then rose from the dead, and so now can we! We inherit eternal life through this miracle, an incomprehensible concept, bigger than time, bigger than distance, bigger than the world we can imagine. Coming back to earth, we link arms with millions around our planet in one celebration of unity. In typical Sr Sarah fashion, her email was full of joy, she called Easter 'a time of forgiving and sharing', and she wished to share that joy, and her community's thanks, with all of us. In a world filled with turmoil, the peace of Easter does indeed

bring hope to our lives, no matter where we may be on our tiny blue planet.
