From Debbie's Desk

Our beautiful children who are receiving the Blessed Eucharist for the first time, are visible representations to us of the priceless treasure that God offers to each of us in each and every moment, from the instant of our creation through to eternity. As we watch them stretch out their hands to receive Jesus for the first time, we can see ourselves in relationship with our God. The Old Testament tells us that the Chosen People got bored, or lazy, or selfish, or ? in their worship of the 'unseen God'. Unsatisfied with experiencing God through the memory of his goodness to them in the miracles of their past, and through faith, they made a golden calf to worship. It was spectacular, no doubt, and something that they could see and touch. Yet it was just a lump of metal. They wanted to experience 'God' on their own terms, from their human perspective, and they made sure that their 'God' fit their own recipe, by manufacturing what they thought he might look like from their imaginations. They totally missed God's presence. Again and again, God drew them back to him when they wandered away from him, despite their stubbornness, ever faithful to the covenant he made with them, that he would be their God and they would be his people, no matter how many times they failed to live up to their end of the deal. The ultimate gift that we have received as a result of God's faithful covenant to humanity is Jesus. The Unseen God is made visible to us through Jesus, who is truly God and truly human, just like us. We experience the Father by living Jesus' relationship as the Son in a way we can relate to through our own experiences. Jesus promised us that the Holy Spirit will be with us forever. In the Eucharist, we physically receive the host, and we drink from the chalice, the Body and Blood of Christ given to us in a way that we can see and touch. We experience Jesus, and through him, the Father and the Spirit. As we see these innocent children reaching for Jesus as food for their journey, we are reminded of God's longing to give us his fullness, if we just open our hands and our hearts. We will never be offered a more precious gift, God's love is ours for the taking if we just open ourselves to be filled.
