From Debbie's Desk

Have you ever considered how much time and effort goes in to choosing the hymns for our weekend Masses? It is not just a case of choosing something we haven't sung for awhile, or that members of our community particularly like. Those who volunteer to serve our parish in this way spend hours of their time considering the readings and the theme of each Mass, choosing hymns that support each movement for that particular Mass, or for the Feast we may be celebrating, in the best possible way. We sing together, worshipping in prayer with one beautiful, powerful voice, for the entrance of the Priest and Deacon, at the Presentation of the Gifts, as we move forward to receive the Eucharist, for the Reflection time following Holy Communion, and as we leave the church, sent out to serve God. The hymns chosen suit the actions that they support. A single hymn played at different times of the Mass may reflect different moods, creating joy as we gather, our prayerful contemplation when played during our Communion reflection time, or our mission if it is played as we leave. Tempo is important. During Advent and Lent, our hymns are quieter, more reflective, than the hymns chosen during Easter time, for instance, when we are filled with joy as we celebrate our risen Lord. Those who are associated with our music ministry are often 'unsung' (sorry, couldn't resist that!), they do a wonderful job, and it is terrific to be able to say 'thanks' occasionally – **and we do today**. Those who choose the hymns, press the buttons, play the instruments, sing the hymns as a choir, and we who sing along are all using our talents to support those who may not be so talented in this area... (I know my limits, singing is not one of my strengths!). Thanks to those who make us all sound so good each week! I am sure God is royally entertained, and very aware that the dedicated efforts of our musicians and iPad jugglers help us to pray right from the heart.
